The URP and ISRDP Nodes

The Urban Renewal Programme (URP) and the Integrated Sustainable Rural Development Programme (ISRDP) consists of 21 nodes across South Africa within which some ten million of South Africa’s poorest citizens live.

These nodes are specifically mentioned in both Code 600 (Enterprise Development) and Code 700 (Corporate Social Investment). Contributions to beneficiaries in these nodes will result in enhanced recognition or bonus points as the case may be.

The Nodes and the Codes

Enterprise Development

Contributions which directly contribute towards the creation of employment opportunities:

- in rural communities and
- any geographic areas identified in the government's Integrated Sustainable Rural Development and Urban Renewal Programmes

qualify for recognition of **1.5** to the actual Rand value of the contribution. This contribution also qualifies for a bonus point.

Corporate Social Investment

A single bonus point is awarded for contributions that benefit people living in rural areas or living in the Government's ISRDP and URP in the preceding year.
